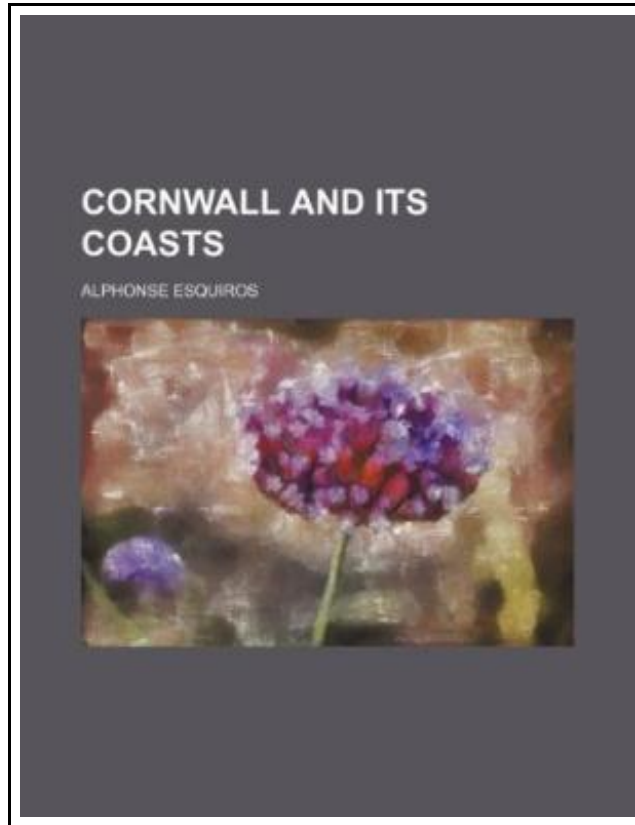

In the port are the masts of sixty luggers--large vessels which annually pursue the mackerel, from March...
