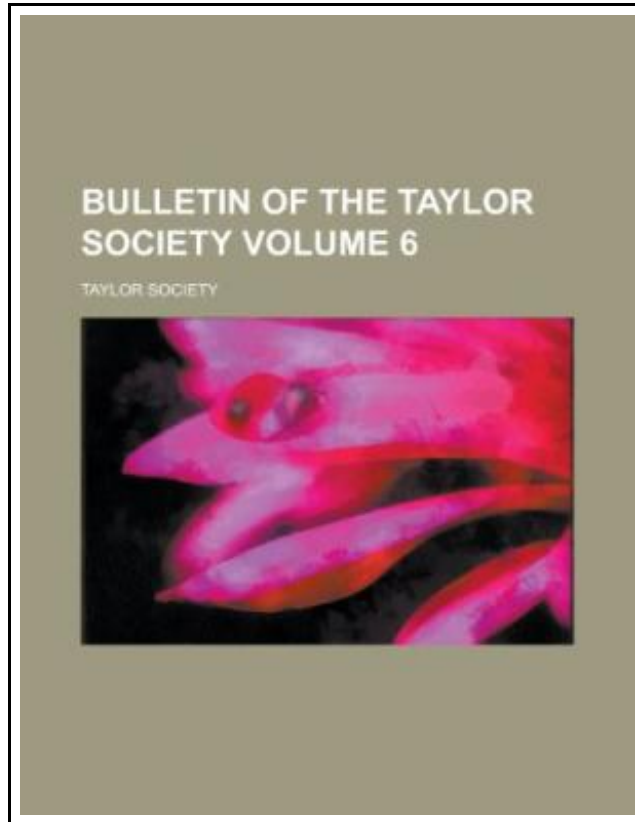

Each machine has its advantage. The advantage of the Burroughs is that it is more nearly automatic, in that it prints the results of all calculations, while the Elliott-Fisher merely indicates such results on a dial or counter for the operator to copy as in typewriting.
